History of the Building

The Wool Hall was built in 1828-30 as a fleece warehouse; it was also used as a billet for troops during the Bristol Riots of 1831.

The architect was Richard Shackleton Pope, who designed many of Bristol's best known buildings, including Bush House, Corn St Magistrates' Court and St Mary on the Quay.

It was converted for use as offices in 1982.

Terms

Rents start from £9 per sq foot per annum, together with an additional £30.06 per sq foot per annum for services which include business rates, water and sewerage charges, gas, electricity, cleaning, insurance and reception facilities, and the rental on telephones and photocopiers.

A simple licence agreement can be established based on a three-month period to provide maximum flexibility.
